CYSA DISTRICT V JAMBOREE POLICY

This policy is in effect for any and all Jamborees held within District V. The rules below supersede the CYSA rules where applicable.

1. League member is required to contact the League President for approval of date, number of teams and from where the teams will be traveling from as well as any nominal fee requested of each team, on the CYSA District V Jamboree request form .
2. League President will inform the member of the rules pertaining to a sanctioned Jamboree:
 - a. No entry fees are permitted.
 - b. No standings are to be kept.
 - c. No awards are permitted unless for all participants.
 - d. Hosting member may request a nominal fee of \$50 to help cover any cost. With the District Commissioner's approval, a higher entry fee may be charged.
 - e. Team s traveling from another district **MUST** have the approval of their District Commissioner or designee of the commissioner.
 - f. Other criteria as established by the host League.
 - g. **NO JAMBOREE may be held in District V on a weekend when the host league is also hosting a CYSA sanctioned tournament.**
3. The Coach or League President will forward the request to the District Tournament Coordinator for approval, ten days prior to the jamboree. The jamboree request form must be completely filled out and signed by the appropriate league official.
4. Send form to Ken Stelling, 6 Barona Court, Santa Rosa, CA 95405. Enclose a self addressed envelope with the correct postage so that signed form may be returned. Form may be faxed to 546-1832, and will be returned via fax .
5. Any league or team that has been placed on probation or is in bad standing will not be permitted to host or attend a jamboree during that time.
6. **Suspensions for Send-offs, red cards, or ejection from tournaments or league games may not be served at Jamborees.**

A competition involving more than two teams in which each team plays multiple games and is limited to no more than 3 age divisions of 8 teams each, for a maximum of 24 teams. Jamborees are sanctioned by the District Commissioner and/or District Tournament Coordinator of the host district. No league or group may host a jamboree without the prior written permission of the District Commissioner or the District Tournament Coordinator as the District Commissioner's designee. Jamborees will comply with CYSA policies, procedures, rules and regulations. **Districts may establish jamboree policies and procedures that are more restrictive than those indicated in the CYSA tournament manual.** Jamborees may be held on any weekend. No league or group hosting a jamboree may charge a team any fees other than those necessary to pay for costs actually and reasonably incurred in hosting the jamboree and in no event shall the fees charged exceed \$50 per team without the approval of the District Commissioner or District Tournament Coordinator based on written justification for a fee in excess of \$50 submitted at the time the league or group applies for permission to host a jamboree. Jamborees may not keep standings. Jamborees may not give awards in any form unless the same award is given to every participant in the jamboree. Jamborees are to be operated on a "not for profit" basis. Jamborees are not included on the CYSA Tournament Calendar. Teams from outside the host district must inform their District Tournament Coordinator and/or District Commissioner of their intended participation prior to the jamboree.

Applying to Host a Jamboree

Complete the Application to Host a Jamboree form

Attach a copy of the Jamboree rules

Submit to the District Tournament Coordinator for approval

Reports

No later than 2 weeks prior to your event, you must notify the District Tournament Coordinator or District Commissioner of teams accepted. The list must include team's district, team name, league of registration, coach name and phone number, age group, gender & class for every team accepted.

You may be asked to provide a final report to the District Tournament Coordinator including the following information:

1. List of participating teams (include district, league name, coach name, age group, gender and class)
2. Financial report (itemize expenses & include photocopies of receipts for expenditures, itemize income)
3. Summary of event (indicate any highlights, problems, indicate where games were played, refs, etc.)

Please check with your DTC as to whether or not the final report will be required in your district.

Although you cannot make money on the jamboree itself, you can have for profit snack bars, T-shirt sales, BBQ's, raffles, etc. Those items are considered optional and therefore will not be considered as part of the participation fee. No financial report is required for these activities.
